ANSWERS EXPLAINED

Q.1 Correct Answer C:

'A movie' should be used in place of 'the movie because we are not talking about any particular movie. Hence article 'a' will be used in place of them.

Q.2 Correct Answer D:

'a center of attraction' should be replaced with 'the center of attraction'. Since 'the' follows the former noun in a sentence with the structure 'none + of the + noun'. For eg 'The art of living.'

Q.3 Correct Answer A:

'Year' does not begin with vowel sound. Hence, 'a' should be used in place of 'an'.

Q.4 Correct Answer B: (an....the)

Q.5 Correct Answer D: (thethe)

Q.6 Correct Answer D:

Apostrophe's' ('s) should be added to else. i.e. 'else's' should be used in place of 'else' to show a relation'

Q.7 Correct Answer D:

The first noun in a compound noun can indicate the material of which the second is made: "steel door," "stone wall," "rope ladder," "silk shirt," "gold medal." It can also indicate the power or fuel on which the second noun runs: "gas fire," "hydrogen engine," "oil stove."

EXCEPTIONS: We don't use "wool" or "wood" in this way because they form their own adjectives: "woolen" and "wooden. "Golden" is also an adjective, but it's used only figuratively (and not as "made of gold"): "a golden opportunity," "golden hair."

O.8 Correct Answer D:

If a noun ends in "o," "ch," "sh," "ss," or "x," add "es" to the end to form a plural.

EXCEPTION: Words of foreign origin or abbreviated take "s" at the end instead: "dynamodynamos," "kilo-kilos," "kimono-kimonos," "photo-photos," "soprano-sopranos."

'Information' should be used in place of 'informations' since information is an uncountable noun. However, we can make it countable and plural by using 'pieces of information'.
